# It's All Greek to Me

As Historians, we will explore the history of the Ancient Greeks and the city-states of Athenia and Sparta. We will use a variety of secondary sources of information: books, the internet and artefacts to discover what life was like in Ancient Greece and how this civilisation influenced the western world.

As Readers, we will read about the Ancient Greeks, Greek Innovations, Myths and Gods and Who Let the Gods out

As Authors, we will write a descriptive paragraph and 'A day in the life of a dragon'

As Journalists, we will write a newspaper report and persuade people to keep a dragon as a pet!



As Scientists, we will investigate how different Ancient Greek scientists influenced the world. We will explore the different forces of the natural world: gravity, friction, magnets and air and water resistance.

As Artists, we will look at people in action and create images based on the sports men and women from the Olympic games.

As Geographers, we will explore the geographical features of Greece and where it is in the world. We will be using Google Maps and globes to locate where the city-states of Athenia and Sparta used to be.

The children will be experiencing a 'Greek Day' which will include dressing-up, food, dance and music.
