As Scientists, we will investigate how circuits work and observe the changes made when additional bulbs and cells are added.

We will complete a range of STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths) activities, looking at levers, pulleys and the different effects of forces. We will use circuit symbols to create our own circuit diagrams.

We will make a fairground ride with a electrical circuit using a range of investigative skills.



As Readers, we will immerse ourselves in a range of texts, which feature fairgrounds.

As Authors, we will write persuasive letters, poetry and stories based on a fairground setting. We will also create advertising posters for our fairground,

As Designers, we will be designing our own fairground ride .

As Historians, we will look at when fairgrounds became popular and how they have changed through time.

As Artists, we will look at the Lowry painting and will be creating our own background, using wax resistant crayons and watercolours. We will sketch fairground rides. We will make 3d helter-skelters and explore the lettering used at fairgrounds.

As programmers ,we will be using flowol to program a fairground ride.
