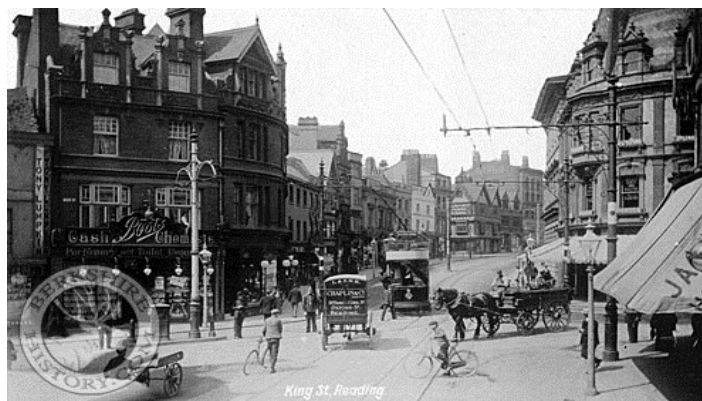
Reading	Writing	Maths

Our Topic this term is ...

The Inventive Victorians

As Historians, we will use secondary sources of information: internet, pictures and artefacts to find out about the Victorians. We will learn about Queen Victoria and the Industrial Revolution. We will also learn about what the Victorians did for us, by looking at inventions from that era. We will be learning about Victorian schools and food, with a focus on Huntley and Palmers.

As Artists, we will be looking at the Victorian artist, William Morris and we will be creating pieces of artwork inspired by
