# The World at War

As Historians, we will explore the history of World War II and the wartime leadership of Winston Churchill. We will learn about the creation of the welfare state and the social, cultural and technological changes in post-war British society. We will evaluate how this historical event has affected life today.



As Scientists, we will investigate how light travels, how it can be blocked and reflected. We will look at how periscopes were used in World War II.

As Artists, we will use a range of materials to create silhouette blitz artwork. We will use our observational skills to draw World War II transport.

As Geographers, we will explore the different countries involved in World War II and discover who were Britain's allies and enemies. We will be using Google Maps and globes to locate the areas that were affected by the war.

As Readers, we will read Goodnight Mr Tom and look at the war from a child's viewpoint.  
As Authors, we will write wartime poems and write letters home.  
As Journalists, we will write a newspaper report and create propaganda posters.

As Designers, we will make our own evacuee 'teddy bear' to take on our journeys.

As Bakers, we will explore rationing and make our own biscuits and cakes using limited ingredients.
