Our Topic this term is ...

Giant's Footsteps

As Readers, we will immerse ourselves in a range of texts which feature Giants.

As authors, we will write a story based on the legend of the Giant's Causeway. We will also create a fact file to describe how the Causeway was formed.

As Designers, we will be creating a 3D model of the Giant's Causeway. We will use a variety of artistic techniques to interpret the Causeway including drawing, shading and sculpture.

In computing, we will use digital/computer mapping to locate Northern Ireland and research the Causeway.



As Geographers, we will use our skills to use maps, atlases and computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.

We will explore the human and physical geography of the Giant's Causeway in Northern Ireland with a focus on erosion.

As Mathematicians, we will investigate the properties of hexagons, using the Giant's Causeway as an inspiration.
