Our Topic this term is ...

AN EGYPTIAN EXPERIENCE

As Historians, we will explore the history of the ancient Egyptians and their way of life.
We will uncover the mystery of the Egyptian mummies and discover why pharaohs were so important.

As Geographers, we will explore the region of Egypt and learn about the importance of the River Nile.

As Engineers, we will investigate why the Egyptians built the pyramids the shape they did and have a go at making our own pyramids.



As Readers, we will read stories based on Egyptian beliefs and read a traditional story with an Egyptian twist. As Authors, we will refine our descriptive writing skills and write in role as an ancient Egyptian.

As Designers, we will create Egyptian style self portraits and transform ourselves into pharaohs using headdresses that we have made. We will also have a go at making our own papyrus paper to test out our Egyptian hieroglyphic writing.

As Scientists, we will investigate the process of mummification.
